CONTENT: This workshop is designed to cover the changes and practical implications of the DSM-IV-TR™ for the EXPERIENCED social work practitioner. Particular emphasis is placed on understanding the use and misuse of the DSM-IV-TR™ within the mental health profession and the medications that are used to treat the disorder.

OBJECTIVES: After completion of the course, participants will be able to: 1) Understand the diversity, necessity and limitations for usage of the DSM-IV-TR™ in the practice environment, 2) Become familiar with the major diagnostic categories and the criteria for proper diagnostic assessments and evaluations, 3) Become familiar with several different advanced practice strategies currently being used to address the diagnostic categories provided, 4) Become familiar with the medications used as part of practice strategy, 5) Understand the importance of utilizing case applications utilizing the multi-axis diagnostic system with children, adolescents and adults, 6) Explore how individuals who suffer from these disorders can be discriminated against within the current mental health system.



PRESENTER: Dr. Sophia F. Dziegielewska, LISW, is a Professor in the School of Social Work at the University of Cincinnati (UC), Ohio. She is also the Editor of the *Journal of Social Service Research*. Educational qualifications include her MSW and PhD in Social Work from Florida State University, Tallahassee, FL. Dr. Dziegielewska is a Licensed Independent Social Worker (LISW) in the State of Ohio. She is the recipient of numerous awards, and supports her research and practice activity with over 119 publications, including seven textbooks, 79 articles, numerous book chapters, and over 400 workshops and community presentations.
